How Do I / We Get Involved in 4-H Has Talent?

- Submit a video no longer than three (3) minutes in length of your best talent.
- Talent submissions must be appropriate for 4-H youth audiences.
- Video entries may consist of an individual or a team. Youth may participate in only one video submission.
- Round Up delegates who are Intermediate and Senior aged 4-H members (13 and up) are allowed to participate in this activity.
- Ten finalists will be selected by the selection committee after the video submission deadline. Entries will be judged on talent, creativity, showmanship, costumes/props, and audience appeal. (see attached score sheet for more information)
- The top 10 finalists will be announced in early June 2012.
- Those ten finalists will then have the opportunity to perform **Friday morning, July 27th**, at the capstone assembly in Gallagher-Iba Arena.
- After all finalists are finished performing, the audience will have the opportunity to vote via text messaging to select the winner.

Deadline for Submission

- All entries must be received (not postmarked!!!) in the State 4-H Office by **May 15, 2012.**

Submission Guidelines

- Maximum Length of video: Three (3) minutes
- Accepted File Formats: Windows Media (.WMV) or .AVI
- Videos are to be burned to a CD or DVD
- The attached Information Form must be sent with the CD/DVD for the entry to be considered.
- Videos and Information Form must be submitted via mail by May 15, 2012 to:
